



PW&S TRAILS



- The PW&S Trail System's trails are rated for moderate- and expert-level riders. Ratings may differ from similar ratings at other mountain bike facilities.
- POWDERMILL LOOP: Expert** 3.5 Miles
 The most challenging trail in the PW&S trail system. Be prepared for rugged terrain, sharp turns and uneven surface.
 - LINN RUN LOOP: Expert** 9.5 Miles
 You'll encounter a total elevation change of 900 feet along a rugged and steep forest access road with sharp turns, switchbacks and a variety of surfaces.
 - LAUREL SUMMIT LOOP: Moderate** 10.5 Miles
 Runs along the top and east slope of Laurel Summit. Enjoy the scenery from Beam Rocks.
 - LOWER BEAM RUN LOOP: Moderate** 7.3 Miles
 Trail includes gravel, loose rock and exposed bedrock surfaces and two steep climbs.
 - SKI AREA LOOP: Moderate** 4.3 Miles
